- Provide staff oversight for the preparation and delivery of well run in-person and live streamed Sunday Celebrations
- Expand Jubilee!'s spiritual offerings to include additional ceremonies, rituals and events with broad appeal to a diverse audience

- Work together with the board and key staff to determine and implement a yet-to-be defined reporting structure for ministerial staff, band, A/V team, volunteers and other individuals who are essential to a well run Sunday Celebrations and other spiritual events
